General Business:

President Jeff went through the *Notes for the Spring Show* to be held at new Venue-Frenchville Sports Club 18/19th Sept.- published in the August Newsletter. Pages 7 and 8.

Signage has started to be put up around the city. Flyers are available for members to put up in shops or businesses. Sales tags and pens available.

Set up of furniture/ stands on Friday 17th begins at 8am when doors open. Help needed. Tony will set up the Club Display structure in the foyer and will also need some help.

Plants for Display-Deliver to foyer **Friday morning**. M. Richardson is leading a group who will do the display.

Show and sales plants may be brought into the main area after 11am to 4pm. Novice Show plants must have a Red Star stamped on plant name tag. Stamp available at venue. Members may purchase plants from Members Sales area 4-5 pm on Friday. No EFTPOS available on Friday. All must vacate by 5pm.

Dinner Saturday night will commence at 7pm. \$20.00 for each member.

During the show, **Entrance is through the Main Club Doors.** There will be an **Exit Only** Door for people to take their purchases out to their cars or leave the show. There is **no storage** at the show. People can be stamped if they wish to return to the show.

Registrar Jeff Glover has organised 4 teams of Judges – mostly local or from Gladstone. Each team will have one Steward.

Foliage Judge will be Ann Oram. S. Frisch will be Steward. Floral Art Judge- Jackie from Allenstown Florist.

Names taken for those entering Container Display section. Anyone else interested -contact Jeff B. Rules for Container Display are in the Show Schedule - August Newsletter.

Free entry to show for Members. Please wear name tags. Door attendants will have a list of members for those who don't have a club name tag. Orders taken for name tags \$15.00 each.

No outside area to sell foliage. Members were asked to book tables for selling their plants.

Excess plants to be stored under sales tables. **Must be kept in a waterproof container** so carpet is protected. All **Bromeliads must be empty of water.**

EFTPOS Facilities will now be available at the show using a Square Reader. \$1.00 surcharge on each transaction.

Bunnings have donated \$150.00 voucher which will be used to buy trolley for Door Raffle. Please bring any donations for the Door Raffle on Friday.

Members encouraged to enter Floral Art Section. Contact Maxine Maunder if in need of help.

New Addition- Best of Foliage Section to have a Rosette as part of prize.

R.O.S.I. SPRING SHOW - 18TH/19TH SEPTEMBER FRENCHVILLE SPORTS CLUB

- (1) Set up of show Friday 17th from 8am to 11am- Helpers required for this!
- (2) Club display If you have plants for this, please bring in during the morning, plants in display will be judged if have name tag on them.
- (3) All other show plants and sales plants cannot be brought in until after **11am** when set up of the show is completed. Don't forget you cannot enter any orchid or foliage plant that has not been registered with its unique number and name label.
- (4) Tabling of show and sales plants finished by 4pm. Tables In sales area will have names on them if booked. If you do not have a table booked you may put your plants on the tables without names on them.
- (5) Club and vendors sales open from 4-5 for members, you must take your purchases home with you, not to be left at show.
- (6) Make sure your sales plants have sales tags with your bar-code price on them, available from Trish or Barry. You cannot sell a plant if not priced correctly.
- (7) All plant name tags for your show plants must come from Trish or Barry. Your list of plants must be with them as soon as possible, Shut off Wednesday of show week. No labels will be printed after then.
- (8) Show judging will be on the Friday night, there will be a light dinner for Judges-Stewards and officials that evening prior to judging of show. If you are not in this group, you will be required to leave by 5pm.
- (9) The show dinner is here in Show area commencing 7pm Cost is \$20 each payable on night. The dinner will be an alternate drop. There will be the usual large show multi draw raffle.
- (10) If you have a donation to put in the trolly door raffle, please drop off on the Friday. Also please help with any cut orchid flowers and foliage you can spare for our ladies to make the posies we sell at show. Any flower you think suitable ok.
- (11) Please remember to have your name badge on when entering show or you may be charged an entry fee.
- (12) Show closes 3pm on the Sunday, helpers required after then to dismantle and clean up the show area.
